Support Local 4616 stand up for fairness in Bonfield

Members of CUPE Local 4616 were forced into a defensive strike on August 1. Their employer, the Township of Bonfield, threatened to impose a contract that allowed contracting-out of public services and many concessions.

Instead of finding solutions to benefit both the local community and municipal workers, Bonfield's mayor and city council have taken extreme actions including closing the municipal dump, hiring scabs, cancelling town council meetings and firing five of the 16 striking workers.

Support our sisters and brothers in their brave stand for fairness in Bonfield, and send a message to governments and employers that CUPE members will stand together against bullies everywhere.
