

Important Per Capita Tax and Credential Dates

- Locals must be paid up to December 31st 2015 in order to receive credentials to be able to register for the CUPE Ontario Convention
- To be entitled to representation at Convention, each Locals Per Capita Tax payments must be paid on its total membership up to and including March 31st of the year in which the Convention is held. **Such payment must be received by April 30th.**
- Any local that has not paid up its per capita by April 30th, 2016, will be subject to the **convention late fee** for all registered delegates, alternates, and guests as per [Article 4(d)2.b)] of the CUPE Ontario Constitution.
- If your Local does not have their March earnings available in time to send in your Per Capita payment, please feel free to estimate your March 2016 payment using your February 2016 wages as a guide. If required, adjustments will be made in the following quarter.
- Article 6.7 of the CUPE National constitution provides that no organization, in arrears two (2) or more months with per capita tax payments to the national union, will be allowed representation at convention. Please ensure that the CUPE National per capita tax payments for your local are up to date.

- If you send your registration fees for the Convention in to CUPE Ontario after April 30th, your Local will be subject to the **convention late fee** for all delegates, alternates, and guests as per [Article 4(d)2.b)] of the CUPE Ontario Constitution.
