Re: CONVENTION 2016 Election of Executive Board and Trustees

As a result of constitutional changes made at the CUPE Ontario 2015 Convention the elections for the new **Equality Representative** positions will take place in their respective caucuses at Convention. All other election processes for the Executive Board and Trustees will remain the same.

These elections are extremely important, as members elected to the Executive Board will help shape the course CUPE Ontario takes over the next 2 years. We strongly encourage all Locals to attend Convention and to actively participate in the election process by identifying and selecting delegates interested in running for the Executive Board and Trustee positions.

The following positions will be elected by convention as a whole:

- President
- Secretary Treasurer
- First Vice-President
- Second Vice-President
- Third Vice-President
- Fourth Vice-President
- Six (6) Executive Members at Large
- One (1) Trustee (not on the Executive Board)

The following positions will be elected at convention in their respective caucuses:

- Equality Representative Aboriginal Workers
- Equality Representative Racialized Workers
- Equality Representative Pink Triangle
- Equality Representative Women
- Equality Representative Workers with Disabilities
- Equality Representative Young Workers
- Representative Northern Ontario

1. *Any member who has declared for election to any position, and makes it known in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer no later than 75 days prior to convention during the year of an election, shall be given the opportunity to provide up to a one hundred and fifty (150) word statement as an election profile that shall be printed and distributed through regular mail and posted on-line. CUPE Ontario will not be responsible for translating individual candidates' election material.*
