The McGuinty government is about commit an unconscionable crime against Ontario's water.

As soon as the ground thaws, Miller Waste, one of the companies behind the disgraced Adams Mine Project (http://www.web.net/nwatch/garbage/CHRONOLOGYofADAMSMINE.htm) to bring Toronto garbage to an abandoned mine shaft in Northern Ontario, will begin "de-watering" an artesian aquifer near Tiny Township, Simcoe County to build another dump that Ontario doesn't need.

Scientists have called the water on and around the site among the purest in the world. It is cleaner than ancient arctic ice and serves as a natural surface spring for the settlers and First Nations communities in area. Information about the extent of the aquifer underneath the proposed dump site is uncertain, but some studies show it linked to underground water systems as far south as Lake Ontario.

It should be a no-brainer. To drain a surface spring so you can put a new dump on top of a pristine aquifer is a **criminal act**. But McGuinty doesn't get it. We have to force him to cancel the water taking permit for Site 41.
