

## **STOP DUMP SITE 41**

It's not too late to stop this imminent threat to Georgian Bay and the purest groundwater in the world.

Tiny Township cottagers, First Nations people and the local agricultural community are calling for a one-year moratorium on construction of this unnecessary, uneconomic and dangerous dump.

Now is the time to tell Simcoe County councillors that we expect them to address the serious concerns raised by the Environmental Commissioner of Ontario and the Community Monitoring Committee. This cannot be done after the fact.

## Site 41 is only 15 km from Georgian Bay. The threat to the bay's beautiful waters is three-fold:

- 1. Contamination of the underlying aquifer causing a toxic plume to leave the site
- 2. Surface water contamination infiltrating the Wye River system
- The toxic leachate pumped out of the site has to be treated: one
  plan is to tanker-truck it to the Midland sewage treatment plant. The
  problem is that routinely, when there's a storm (just when there's the
  most leachate from the dump), the plant is overwhelmed and releases
  untreated effluent to the bay.

In the face of these threats, a one-year moratorium is only reasonable. This is about our families and their future. Let's not take any chances.
