

PANTALONE SUPPORT GROWING / STRATEGIC VOTING REJECTED

Pantalone Campaign HQ was packed with media this morning as more elected officials and candidates turned their back on strategic voting and came out to ask Toronto to elect Joe Pantalone as our new Mayor.

City Councillors Janet Davis and Gord Perks, Catholic School Trustee Catherine LeBlanc Miller, Council Candidate Mike Layton, MPP Rosario Marchese and former Toronto District School Board Chair; the hugely respected Fiona Nelson, all joined Joe and cheering supporters at Mayor Joe HQ. This adds to a list of supporters already including sitting Mayor David Miller and Councilor Paula Fletcher as well as area MP Olivia Chow and Federal NDP Leader Jack Layton.

With the Smitherman-Ford dead-heat becoming old news, and 20% of voters still undecided, more people are taking a fresh look at Pantalone.

Today's news conference was an opportunity for Joe to remind voters that even one day is a lifetime in politics and, as he said, "we have seven before voting day." "Don't let the newspapers decide who wins this election," Pantalone asked the crowd, "let the people of Toronto decide when they vote next Monday."
