
"Mobilizing Together Toward 2014"

WE ARE WORKING IN

Toronto

Where the Mayor is threatening to contract out "anything that is not nailed down", deliberately created a \$780M deficit for 2012

Where Local 416 has worked hard with other CUPE Locals and allies to stop the contracting out of solid waste, recently succeeding in slowing down the Mayor's push to privatize.











WE WILL

Work together with the Social Service Sector to fight the "Core Services Review in Toronto which threatens:

- All city-run public services, including Libraries
- Publically owned assets like Toronto Hydro and the Toronto Parking Authority
- Community Agencies that receive any municipal funding







WE WILL

- Continue to work with the School Board and Social Service Sectors to ensure the full funding and implementation of the Early Learning Program (ELP)
- Demand the provincial government provide stabilization funding for community, not-for profit and municipal child care to adjust to ELP




WE WILL
