Toronto –

- “The People’s Court” at 1pm at the Toronto Court House at 361 University Avenue (at Armoury St). We are placing the austerity agenda and our political representatives, including Harper, Hudak, McGuinty and Ford on trial for the sweeping cuts to public services communities rely upon.

Thunder Bay –

- Demonstration and rally at the Lakehead Labour Centre (929 Fort William Rd, Thunder Bay) at noon.

Kingston –

- “Bon Voyage to Harper and his Austerity Measures!” Demonstration at Confederation Park (2-24 Clarence St, Kingston) at noon.

London –

- Rally at Victoria Park (509 Clarence St., London – near the bell tower) at 1pm.

Sudbury –

- Community BBQ in the Market Square (Corner of Elm and Elgin St.) at 1pm.
