## ONDP Pharmacare for Everyone vs Liberal OHIP+

	NDP Pharmacare for Everyone	Liberal OHIP+
<b>What is it?</b>	Universal Pharmacare	A new drug program, on top of the 6 public drug programs that Ontario already operates
<b>Who will be covered?</b>	All Ontarians	Children and youth under age 25
<b>How many people?</b>	Almost 14 million (All Ontarians)	Approx. 4 million
<b>Is this a universal plan?</b>	Yes	No. It excludes everyone 25 or older
<b>How many people without any coverage today will have coverage under this plan?</b>	Over 2.2 million	Unknown
<b>How many working people without coverage will have coverage?</b>	All working people of all ages	Only workers under 25 years of age
<b>Who loses coverage?</b>	No one	Anyone who turns 25
<b>Who is excluded?</b>	No one	People age 25-64
<b>How many drugs covered?</b>	125 essential medicines for the most common conditions (to meet the majority of primary care needs) and expanding to reach comprehensive coverage	4,400 drug products and dosages listed separately on the Ontario Drug Benefit Formulary
<b>What is the cost of the program?</b>	\$475 Million	\$465 Million
