### **This year marks the 10-year anniversary of the Casa Verde Inquest.**

That inquest looked into the 2001 death of two residents at the hands of another resident living at the Casa Verde nursing home in Toronto and made many recommendations to keep residents safer. Years later, few of these recommendations have been acted on by the province.

CUPE Ontario Health Care Workers Coordinating Committee (HCWCC) and the Ontario Council of Hospital Unions (OCHU) have worked with the Ontario Health Coalition to commemorate this anniversary with a memorial for residents who have died as a result of homicide while living in long-term care homes.

Join us to remember those who have died due to homicide and to demand the Ontario government implement the coroner's recommendations of a minimum care standard to meet the care needs of residents in long-term care and to protect against harm.
