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2015 marks the 10-year anniversary of the Casa Verde Inquest into the tragic deaths (in 2001) of two long-term care residents at the hands of another resident at the home. Since then, more than 25 long-term care residents in Ontario have died as a result of violence from other residents. In the Casa Verde Inquest, the coroner's jury recommended minimum care standards and improved staffing levels. Today, 10 years later, the Ontario Government still has not implemented these recommendations.

Join us in our Time to Care - March for Remembrance to Liberal MPP Naqvi's office to demand the Casa Verde Inquest recommendations be implemented and ask him if he will support 4 hours of hands on care to be made the law in Ontario.
