We are urging the Board of Directors to lead by example and demonstrate why they won the Public Library Board of the Year award by paving the way for management to return to the bargaining table with a respectable and conciliatory attitude and bargain to reach a fair collective agreement.

Parties are scheduled for mediation on March 23rd, 2016, with a lock out or strike deadline of March 24th, 2016 at 12:01 a.m.
