The Ontario Federation of Labour and the Ontario Network of Injured Workers Groups are sponsoring an exciting Workers' Compensation Conference, November 3 & 4, 2016 at the United Steelworkers Hall in downtown Toronto. At this conference we are celebrating the 25th Anniversary of the ONIWG, reflecting on our victories and lessons learned. We will look at new developments in workers' compensation, including work-related mental health conditions, recent WSIAT decisions and new developments at the WSIB. We will also set goals and actions to engage injured workers and WCB activists.

As well, we will review recent changes at the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB), discuss problematic sections of the legislation and policy. We will then strategize efforts to lobby the government with our system partners to make the system fairer for injured workers.
