During the COVID-19 pandemic, frontline workers like yourselves have gone above and beyond in order to support the public. At the height of the pandemic, we understood that we all had to make sacrifices for the greater good. But as the province reopens, we do not believe that it should only be frontline workers continuing to make sacrifices.

With Bill 195, emergency orders that were supposed to be temporary and which permitted employers to ignore sections of our collective agreements, are now extended indefinitely.

This is an extraordinary, undemocratic, and unprecedented abuse of power. Front-line workers – who helped keep us safe and delivered the critical services in a pandemic – deserve better than an attack on their legal rights.
