

2022 Convention Call

CUPE Ontario School Board Council of Unions 5th Annual Convention

March 21 to March 25th 2022

FIRST CALL

In accordance with Article 15 of the OSBCU Bylaws, you are hereby notified that the 5th Annual Convention of the Council will convene in person at 6pm Monday March 21, 2022 and will conclude Friday, March 25th, 2021 at Ceasars in Windsor. Information sessions for OMERS and the Education Workers Benefit Trust will be held on March 21, 2022.

Representation at Convention

Affiliated Locals are entitled to the following representation (Article 4.1.01)

Basis of Representation	Maximum Number of Delegates
1 to 100 members	Two delegates
101 to 200 members	Three delegates
201 to 300 members	Four delegates
301 to 400 members	Five delegates
401 to 500 members	Six delegates
501 to 600 members	Seven delegates
601 to 700 members	Eight delegates
701 to 850 members	Nine delegates
851 to 1000 members	Ten delegates

Add one delegate for each additional 500 members. (Article 4.1.02)

Local unions sending one of more delegates who identify as a member of an equity seeking group (Racialized Workers, 2SLGBTQ+ Workers, Workers with Disabilities, Women Workers, Young Workers, Francophone and Indigenous Workers) shall be entitled to one (1) additional delegate. (*Article 4.1.04*)

To be entitled to representation at Convention, a Local Affiliated Union shall have paid per capita tax up to and including December 31st, 2021 (*Article 4.1.08*). Such payment must be received by February 11, 2022.

Additionally, *Article 6.7* of the National Constitution provides that no organization in arrears two (2) or more months with per capita tax payments to the National Union will be allowed representation at Convention.

The membership upon which the per capita payment for the last quarter of the calendar year preceding Convention is made shall be used for the purpose of determining delegate representation at Convention.

Alternate Delegates

An affiliated Local Union may elect alternate delegates to attend annual Conventions. An alternate delegate shall be entitled to attend session of the Convention and shall be entitled to voice but no vote except in the absence of a duly elected delegate ($Article\ 4.1.03\ a\ \&\ b$)

Resolutions and Bylaw Amendments

All resolutions and bylaw amendments to be considered at a Convention must be submitted by an Affiliated Local Union, or Executive Board or Committee thereof to the office of the Secretary-Treasurer and **must not exceed 200 words in total**.

December 17th, 2021 is the deadline for receiving Resolutions and Constitutional Amendments.

Please note that due to the early date of CUPE Ontario Convention, resolutions that are submitted which would require submission to CUPE Ontario for consideration will not be possible. Our convention date is following the CUPE Ontario deadline.

All resolution and bylaw amendments must be submitted on the OSBCU forms (in a word document) and signed by the Presiding Officer and Secretary of such affiliate. Please address resolution and bylaw amendment to Mike Maguire at info@osbcu.ca, ensuring that all originals are forward to the OSBCU office immediately thereafter. Please note documents sent to any other email address will not be considered for submission.

Elections

During the 2022 Convention there will be elections for the following positions:

- Injured Worker Representative (by election term ending 2024)
- 3-year Trustee (term ending 2025)
- Equity Representative (new position term ending 2024)
- Area 1 Vice President (by election in Area 1 caucus only term ending 2024)
- Area 7 Area Mobilization Officer (by election in Area 7 caucus only term ending 2024)

Any member who has declared election to any position, and makes it known in writing to the Secretary Treasurer **no later than February 21, 2022** shall be given the opportunity to provide a one page, black and white election letter or flyer. A copy of the material will be sent to all locals in advance of the convention. Every effort should be made for election materials to be bilingual.
