Instructions for volunteers supporting the Ontario Health Coalition (OHC) workplace referendum

A – You have been provided leaflets, ballots, and pledge forms.

B – Please have everyone who votes sign to take the pledge that they are 16 years or older, a resident of Ontario, and will only vote once. Please tell them their address and postal code will not be shared or added to any lists.

C – All votes are secret. Please give people privacy as they vote.

D – Please make sure that voters know a NO vote means they are voting to stop the privatization of our hospitals.

E – Please have voters fold their ballot in half where indicated and put it into the ballot box.

F – When you are finished, please use the extra red duct tape on the side of the ballot box to cover the hole on the top (where votes are put) and sign across the edge of the tape to indicate that you have sealed it.

G – Please return unused ballots, leaflets, all filled/unused pledge sheets, and the sealed ballot box to your local health coalition or other health coalition representative as arranged.
