Timeline for CUPE locals holding workplace referendums

April 18: Local health coalitions across the province hold local news conferences with their local media to announce the dates of the community referendums, May 26 and 27.

- CUPE locals holding workplace referendums are invited to approach their local health coalitions about joining their local press conference.
- OHC will provide materials to support workplace referendums for participating locals.

May 2: Online voting opens for those who can't vote in community or workplace referendums.

May 7: Local health coalitions announce locations of community referendums.

May 15-22: Workplace referendums will take place, with voting by paper ballots and online.

May 28 and 29: Voting results will be tabulated by Ontario Health Coalition.

May 31: Ontario Health Coalition will deliver 1 million ballots to Queen's Park, supported by OCHU, CUPE Ontario and other allies.

June 1: Ontario Legislature rises for summer break.
