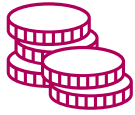


Top 10 Ford Fails

If you think this election does not matter – think again. You, your family, and your community have been negatively impacted by the Ford Conservatives.



Cost of Living – Life is getting harder, and this government doesn't care. Groceries are up 24%. Housing? Up 23%. And homelessness? Up 25%, hitting 80,000 people. 1 in 16 people visited a foodbank last year. 1 in 7 lacks a doctor. And what's Ford's solution? Election bribes and a gas tax cut worth pocket change. We deserve better.

Equity – Ford is failing on equity. He ignores trans rights, lets hate crimes surge, and scapegoats immigrants. Instead of protecting vulnerable communities, he fuels division and fear.



Housing – Ontario's housing crisis is worse than ever. Doug Ford pledged to build 1.5 million new homes, but housing starts have plunged to a 69-year low. Developers get handouts, while everyday people are priced out. Ford's failure is fueling the crisis.

Hallway Medicine - Hallway medicine in Ontario is at a crisis point and it is compromising patient health and safety. Despite Ford's promises, the number of patients treated in hallways has skyrocketed by 125% since he took office.



Privatization – Ford's privatization push is selling Ontario to the highest bidder. Liquor sales? Handed to big business. Health care? Private clinics profiting off public needs. Ontario Place? A corporate playground. Ontarians pay the price for privatization.

Wage Freeze - Bill 124 illegally suppressed workers wages, violating the Charter of Rights and Freedoms. The legislation held wages to 1% during record high inflation of 6.8%. This wage theft took on average \$25,629 out of the pockets of over 500,000 public sector workers.



Public Services - The Ontario government is bribing voters with \$200 rebate cheques while slashing public services by \$385 per person in 2025. The result? Kids in motels due to child welfare cuts, more violence in classrooms, and 1 in 5 ERs shut down as private clinics profit.

Greenbelt Scandal - A shady \$8 billion land deal benefited connected developers. Insiders profited while protected green space vanished. Now, the RCMP is investigating this backroom betrayal of public trust.



Homelessness – Ontario has over 80,000 people who are unhoused and 1,000+ encampments. Instead of offering real solutions, Ford wants to trample vulnerable people's rights and criminalize poverty. Housing is a right—not a crime.

Right to Strike – In 2022 Bill 28 imposed a contract on education workers, stripping them of the right to bargaining key issues like wages and benefits. Education workers fought back and won, but Bill 28 set a dangerous precedent for future labor disputes.
