Day of Action for Civil Liberties

Saturday, July 10, 1 p.m. @ Queen's Park

During the G20 Summit in Toronto on June 26 and 27, police used raids, rubber bullets, tear gas and pre-emptive detentions on peaceful protesters. In total, more than 1000 people were detained based on dubious charges, in the largest mass arrest in Canadian history.
