

Call your councillor now

If you live and work in Prince Edward County (PEC), CUPE Ontario urges you to take action immediately to stop a proposed P3 public-private partnership.

On Monday September 22, Prince Edward County Council will decide whether to build its new wastewater treatment plant as a public venture or pay a group of private operators to design, build and operate it as a public-private partnership (P3). CUPE 2275 and CUPE Ontario are distributing flyers throughout the county urging residents to call their councilors before the vote. This action follows months of efforts by our union and our researchers to educate local councillors on why P3s cost more and deliver less.
