Investments in Poverty Reduction

An Increase in the Ontario Child Benefit to \$92 a month in 2009 budget and \$125 a month in 2010 budget

\$100 monthly Healthy Food Supplement to help all adults on social assistance access healthier food and investments to make progress on poverty reduction plans

Housing Investments:

A long-term affordable housing strategy including immediate Investments to build affordable housing, provide shelter subsidies/benefits and upgrade existing social housing

Recession Relief & Community Supports

Investments in the non-profit sector and to recession relief (employment and training programs) and protections to support Ontarians during the economic downturn
