Re: Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System (OMERS)

Dear Premier:

CUPE Ontario and its members remain very concerned about the contribution rate increase being proposed by OMERS.

On May 10, 2005, we wrote to the OMERS board chair, Frederick Biro, informing him that we required the necessary plan documentation and information for us to do an independent actuarial assessment of the valuation results at December 31, 2004. As a significant stakeholder to the OMERS plan, we believed this information would be made available. However, to-date, we have received no response from OMERS.

Mr. Premier, as I have requested in previous correspondence, the province should not be approving any contribution increases recommended by OMERS' board and management until there has been complete openness and transparency with the relevant data.

I have also attached for your perusal, the letter to Mr. Biro referred to herein.
