The provincial government is changing the way hospitals are funded, moving away from block grants (called hospital global budgets) to a type of fee-for-service funding.

This is a revolutionary change. If it is adopted, it means the end of community hospitals as we know them. It means major hospital restructuring. It means the centralization of procedures and major changes for the workforce. It entails a host of new administrative costs.

This system has already been tried in the UK where it resulted in serious financial instability for hospitals, privatization and major cuts. Come to your local summit to hear from policy experts, labour leaders, and seniors' organizations about their concerns and what we can do about it.
