The university's administration wants the right to change our schedules with little or no notice. They want to reduce our benefits. They want to hire workers to do the same jobs that we do, but on lower pay and without benefits.

We recognize that the pressure on Queen's to reduce costs is the result of government underfunding for universities. If Queen's administration wants to address that issue, we're on board. But its current approach harms our community, the services that we provide, and the quality of life on campus for students and staff.
